Jamboree-on-the-Air, or JOTA, is the largest Scouting event in the world. It is held annually during the third full weekend in October. JOTA uses amateur radio to link Scouts and Radio operators around the world, around the nation, and in your own community.

(Unlike other Jamborees,) This jamboree requires minimal travel. It's a great way to get more youth interested in amateur radio while demonstrating the fun as well as the service aspects

of amateur radio. The scope of your JOTA activities is only limited by your imagination.

Any amateur mode of operation can be used such, as CW, SSB, PSK, SSTV, FM, and satellite. The more modes in operation, the more exciting the event will be for the Scouts. JOTA is not a contest. The idea is to contact other Scout stations and allow as many Scouts as possible to talk to other Scouts.
